

Judiciary Report on the Constitutionality of the Yale-NUS College Council

March 2016

In the month of March 31st, the Yale-NUS College Judiciary noted one violation of the Yale-NUS College Student Government Constitution, but the matter was adequately addressed.

The one violation noted was that the Yale-NUS College Council failed to disclose any potential conflicts of interest, pursuant to Article VII Section 2.13. The conflict has subsequently been remedied as the Council stated its potential conflicts in a weekly meeting with proper minutes and which was subsequently publicized.

The Yale-NUS College Judiciary has noted its conflict of interests and has sent these to the Council Director of External Communications, satisfying the requirement imposed by Article VII.
