Minor constitutional changes	<u>Leave of Absence</u> Article VIII: Removal from Office, Resignation, Leave of Absence, and Dissolution To add: Section 5: Leave of Absence Any member of the Government may voluntarily take a Leave of Absence from Student Government only in the event of extended "acceptable absences," as outline in Article VII, Section 2.1. The member must submit a letter in writing to the President declaring their intention to take a leave of absence, but the leave will not be official until it receives approval from the President.
