Commitment to Improving Sexual Assault Policies, Procedures & Resources on Campus

Whereas the Council

1. Recognises that occurrences of sexual assault take place on the Yale-NUS campus within the community; and
2. Recognises that current policies, procedures, and resources are insufficient to meet the needs of students as regards sexual assault; and
3. Understands that a working committee for reviewing and improving policies and procedures surrounding sexual assault has been set up; and
4. Recognises that the Council has a responsibility to the student body to improve the conditions on campus surrounding sexual assault; and
5. Recognises that the Council is in a position to engage in ongoing dialogue between students and faculty regarding sexual assault; and
6. Recognises the importance of the Council's involvement with shaping sexual assault policies, procedures, and resources on campus.



Therefore, be it resolved by the Council that

1. At least one member of the Council shall be part of the working committee mentioned in the earlier Section 3; and
2. The Council will review any survey questions before they are released to the student body; and
3. The Council will continue to work with students and faculty on improving policies, procedures, and resources surrounding sexual assault on campus.
